ANNEX NO. 1 TO THE REGULATIONS OF ROTARY CUP'25

GDPR Information Clause

for Participants of the Rotary Cup sports event
(fulfillment of the information obligation under Art. 13(1) and (2) of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016)

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Association of Rotary Clubs “District 2231 Rotary International” with its registered office in Łódź, at the address: ul. Dr Seweryna Sterlinga 27/29/501C, 90-212 Łódź, entered in the Register of Associations, Other Social and Professional Organizations, Foundations, and Independent Public Health Care Institutions of the National Court Register maintained by the District Court in Łódź, 20th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under number KRS 0000481209, NIP 7252072333, REGON 101703396.

2. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of organizing the Rotary Cup sports event on the basis of Art. 6(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (OJ EU L 119 of 04.05.2016, p. 1, OJ EU L 127 of 23.05.2018, p. 2, and OJ EU L 74 of 4.03.2021, p. 35), hereinafter referred to as the Regulation.

3. Your personal data may also be processed for the purpose of pursuing or defending claims, on the basis of Art. 6(1)(f) of the Regulation, which constitutes a legitimate interest of the Administrator of your data.

4. The recipients of your personal data will be persons authorized by the Administrator to process personal data as part of the organization of Rotary CUP, as well as entities to which the Administrator commissions activities involving the processing of data. In particular, this includes making data available on the list of event participants and announcing results in specific competitions, entities providing accounting services for the Administrator, IT system administration, and providers of electronic tools used for data storage.

5. Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the Rotary Cup event and thereafter for the period of limitation of any potential claims, but no longer than 10 years.

6. You have the right to access your data and the right to rectify, delete, restrict processing, and the right to data portability as set out in Art. 20 of the Regulation, as well as the right to object.

7. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Regulation.

8. Providing your personal data is voluntary. The consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to participate in the Rotary Cup.

9. Your personal data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be subject to profiling.
