Appendix No. 2 to the Rotary CUP'25 Rules

§1 PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION

- 1.1 Rotary CUP is an event focused on fun, with physical effort and competition for the title of "Best Rotary CUP'25 Club" as its pretext.
- 1.2 A condition for participating is giving consent for the Organizer to record and use participants' image for documentation and promotional purposes. The Organizer and its partners (including sponsors) may use these recordings or photos without time or geographic limitation and without compensation, across all media.
- 1.3 In team sports, individuals outside Rotary clubs may participate if at least one team member is a Rotarian.
- 1.4 Team and player registration occurs via an online form on Rotary District 2231's website and payment of the entry fee.
- 1.5 Once payment is made, the system administrator will verify and confirm the registration within 2 days via email.
- 1.6 The entry fee is 200 PLN or 50€, and allows participation in more than one discipline.
- 1.7 Online registration closes no later than 3 days before the event, i.e., by 24.09.2025.
- 1.8 Non-participants in the sports competitions may join optional sightseeing tours around Spała.

§2 DISCIPLINES AND RULES

- 2.1.1 Shot Put from a Wheelchair
- 5 throws per athlete, seated in a special wheelchair
- Overstepping the line = foul
- Longest valid throw wins
- 2.1.2 Boules (Pétanque)
- Goal: Get boules closer to the small ball ("jack") than the opponent
- Singles (1v1, 3 boules each), Doubles (2v2, 3 each), Triples (3v3, 2 each)
- 13 points to win
- Standard pétanque rules apply
- 2.1.3 Free Throw Basketball
- 10 free throws per player
- Most accurate shots wins
- Tie = 5-shot playoff rounds until winner is determined

2.1.4 Welly Throwing

- 3 throws per participant (men use size 43, women size 38)
- Top 10 get 3 more throws in the final
- Longest valid throw (landing within the lane) wins

2.1.5 Nordic Walking

- ~1 km track
- Use of poles and technique required
- Running/jumping forbidden
- First to cross the finish line wins

2.1.6 Disc Golf

- Throw frisbee into basket in as few throws as possible
- "Hole" ends when disc lands/sticks in basket
- Player moves to next hole and records number of throws

2.1.7 Mixed 4x100m Relay ("Sztacheta Mieszana")

- Mixed-gender teams of 4
- Each runs 100m, baton passed within 20m zone
- Disqualification for early/late passes, lane violation, etc.

2.1.8 Beret Throwing

- 3 throws per person using a 100g beret
- Top 10 from qualifiers throw again
- Landing upright, within the track, without crossing line = valid
- Distance measured from throw line to beret center

2.1.9 Tug of War

- Teams of 4 minimum
- Knockout format
- Equal team sizes matched
- Win by pulling marker past designated zone

2.1.10 Beach Volleyball (3x3)

- Teams: 3 players + 1 sub
- Best of 3 sets to 11 points (must win by 2)
- Group stage and knockout rounds
- Full rules published 24.09.2025 at www.rotarycup.pl

§3 GENERAL CLASSIFICATION SCORING

3.1 Points awarded for 1st-6th place:

Individual: 1st-6 pts, 2nd-5, 3rd-4, 4th-3, 5th-2, 6th-1

Team: 1st-7.5 pts, 2nd-6, 3rd-4.5, 4th-3, 5th-1.5, 6th-1

- 3.2 Total team scores are based on official event results.
- 3.3 Ties broken by number of 1st places, then 2nd, etc.
- 3.4 Scoring committee includes head referee, event chair, discipline judges, and one participant volunteer.
- 3.5 Final results announced at evening ceremony and posted on www.rotarycup.pl.
- 3.6 Appeals must be submitted within 2 days after results announcement.

§4 AWARDS

- 4.1 Medals for top 3 individuals; certificates for clubs.
- 4.2 Main prize (Rotary CUP Trophy) goes to the club with highest total score (individual + team).

§5 FEES

- 5.1 Each participant must pay the start fee.
- 5.2 Entry fee: 200 PLN or 50€.
- 5.3 Fee must be paid during registration.
- 5.4 No refunds for cancellations.

§6 DATA PROTECTION (GDPR)

- 6.1 Personal data processed under EU Regulation 2016/679.
- 6.2 Names and clubs will be published on rotarycup.pl and rotary.org.pl.
- 6.3 Details in Appendix No. 1 to the Rules.

§7 FINAL PROVISIONS

- 7.1 Participants must uphold fair play and respect.
- 7.2 The Organizer resolves disputes and enforces the rules.
- 7.3 The Organizer may amend the rules as needed.
